
Financial and Business Review 2022/23

Revenue and Profit



In 2022/23 we achieved a 12% increase in revenue to £67.3m (2021/22: £60.08m). Net profit rose by 7.7% to £17m (2021/22: £15.7m).

Highlights

Promotions - we promoted 28 team members including five new Partners, four new Legal Directors, 10 new Senior Associates and nine new Associates.

Recruitment - 31 senior lateral hires, including three Partners, joined us this year.

Awards - prestigious award wins across the Midlands, South West and Yorkshire regions, and within the Health & Social Care market.

Office investment - we invested in our Birmingham office relocation to equal our operations in Bristol, Leeds and London.
